as part of onedotzero's live multi-sensory identity, troika have been commissioned to create an installation that represents onedotzero_adventures in motion and the theme 'citystates'. taking the form of a modern digital zoetrope, this cylindrical drum displays a multitude of audio-visual outputs to stunning effect. audio by autobam.

hexstatic + inition: 3d holotronica

stuart warren-hill of hexstatic presents a 3d installation of holotronica – the art of electronic music synchronised with computer generated holography. featuring a 3d version of the onedotzero ident remix plus unique remastered hexstatic videos viewed on a wowvx screen without the need for special glasses.

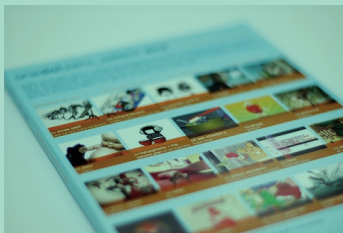
